

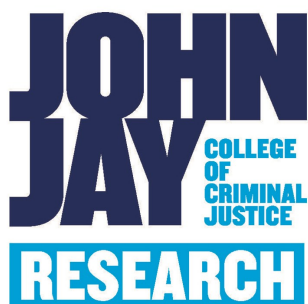
**Book Talk:**
